

On this day 71 years ago concentration camp Auschwitz-Birkenau has been freed by CCCPs Red Army. More than one Million People had been murdered in that place before.

January 27th was declared Day of Remembrance of the fascisms victims. But still there are antisemitic patterns of thinking very popular in todays society; not only with extreme right wings but found in societys centre. Until now a lot of Nazi perpetrator were not called out loud or made accountable; but still people are wresting facts and calling the perpetrators as victims.

For that it is our mission in society aswell as in university to call out loudly any kind of discrimination and to question the ideas of todays education. For never forgetting the victims of shoa and Auschwitz never to be repeated.
